Sew Days

Well folks, we made it through January.

Our Sew Day is fast approaching on Wednesday, February 13 and there will be an opportunity to work on charity quilts for the Cornerstone House for women. Cornerstone just opened a new facility in Westboro which provides permanent housing to women at risk. They are in need of quilts for their single beds.

At our sew day we will have a variety of methods for you to contribute; sewing prepared kits, preparing kits for the long arm quilters (cutting batting, squaring up backs), joining existing squares, piecing backs, etc.

Suggested donations: fabric for backs (we can piece fabrics together to make pleasant combinations), and purple (all ranges of purple) fabrics. We had a donation of purple which have been cut into strips to make scrappy 10.5" blocks.

Looking forward to gathering on Wednesday, February 13 and working together for our community.

At our February Guild meeting kits will be available for machine quilting (top, batting, backing and binding included).

Sew days are held at the Kanata Legion, 70 Hines Road, Kanata. There is a sign-up sheet at each guild meeting. Sew days are \$5.00 for everyone - coffee and tea provided free of charge.

What should you bring to a sew day?

- ✓ Your sewing machine and extension cord
- ✓ Your usual sewing supplies
- ✓ Your lunch and your coffee/tea mug. (Tim Hortons & Starbucks are close by)
- ✓ A small cutting mat for your own table (3 large cutting mats and 3 irons/boards are supplied for general use)

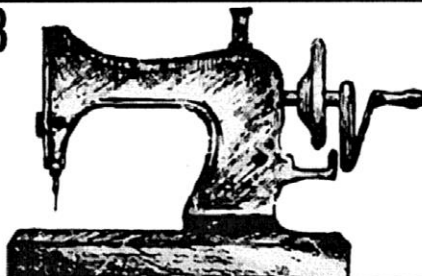

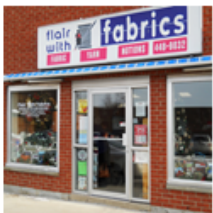
