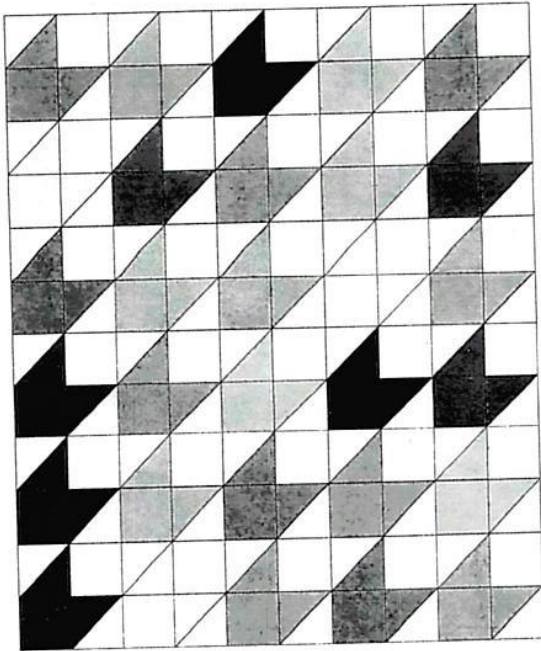


Tulip block



A simple, modern and impactful motif, this tulip creates a bold statement with its focal colored shape, while also creating a secondary tulip in the negative space.

Please chose a low volume print (color Baby blue/powder blue) for the first color, and a print or solid of your choice for the second color.

CUTTING

First color

(1) $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$

(1) $6\frac{7}{8}'' \times 6\frac{7}{8}''$

second color

print or solid

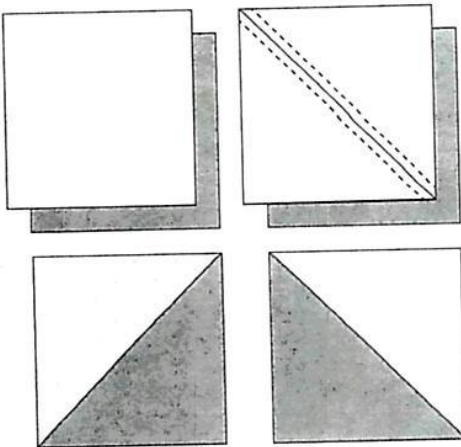

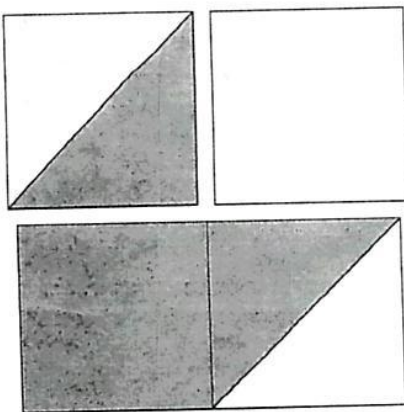
INSTRUCTIONS

1.



1. To create the two HST (half square triangle) blocks, place the two $6\frac{7}{8}''$ squares right sides together. With a ruler, draw a diagonal line from one point to the opposite point. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ from the center line on both sides. Cut along the drawn line, and press open. Trim to $6\frac{1}{2}''$.

2. Arrange and sew the HST blocks with the remaining $6\frac{1}{2}''$ blocks as shown in the picture. Press seams as desired and trim $12\frac{1}{2}''$ if needed.
