

BIRDHOUSES

Use bright and colourful fabrics just because they're fun!
Besides, birds see colour don't they?

CUT

One number 1 rectangle 5 ½" X 3"

Two number 2 squares 3" X 3"

One square 5 ½" X 5 ½"

Use bright colours for all the pieces except No.2 which should be a kind of sky blue

Place the 3" squares at the top corners of rectangle 1 and snowball the corner which will give you a peaked roof. Attach the roof to the rest of the house as shown.

HOLE!! Cut a round piece of contrasting fabric whatever size you like and position in the middle as shown. Use a little glue or some heat & bond to keep it in place. Stitch close to the edge using zig zag or tiny blanket stitch.

Your block should now measure 8" X 5 ½"

This block could be part of a nice bright quilt for Roger's House.
