

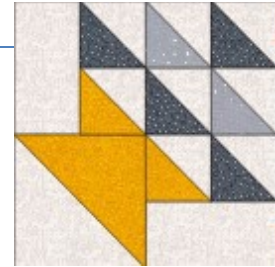
Month 5 – Flower Basket

From Gold cut one (1) 4" x 4" squares and one 7" x 7" square.

From Dark Grey, cut two (2) 4" squares.

From light grey, cut one (1) 4" square.

From background cut four (4) 4"x 4" squares, one 7" square, and two (2) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background 4" squares.
2. Layer a dark grey 5" square right sides together with a background 5" square.
3. Sew 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line you drew.
4. Cut along line, between the two rows of stitching.
5. Press to dark side.
6. This makes 2 HSTs. Repeat to make 2 more.
7. Repeat with the gold/background 4" squares (make 2 HSTs)
8. Repeat with the light grey/background 4" squares (make 2 HSTs)
9. Using the gold/background 7" squares, use the same method to make 2 HSTs. This block will only use one, keep the other for block #2 if you are making the full quilt.
10. Layout your blocks as shown. Take note of the orientation of the HSTs. Assemble your block by sewing the blocks into 4 squares as shown, then sew these together into a block. Press the interior seams towards the dark triangles so that the seams will nest.
11. For the full quilt, you will need 2 of these blocks, which finish at 12.5"x12.5"
